Its safe to say that I (Lisa) get a little bit excited for Halloween, we have lots of decorations up around the home including a huge spider with a 5ft web in the garden!
























Our Halloween decorations in the main entrance ready for the Halloween party – apologies I didn't manage to get any picture of it.

The balloon display was created by Simon who visits every Thursday for the motivational classes, it had been a huge hit with residents, staff, families and visitors a like both professional and otherwise.




We enjoyed some pumpkin carving, which are now ready to welcome you by our door
